COME HELP DECORATE THE CHURCH FOR ADVENT & CHRISTMAS NOVEMBER 24 3:00 PM

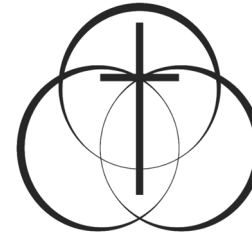
We'll gather in the sanctuary to decorate the Christon Tree and hang wreaths inside and outside. Text or email Pastor Daniel if you can help.

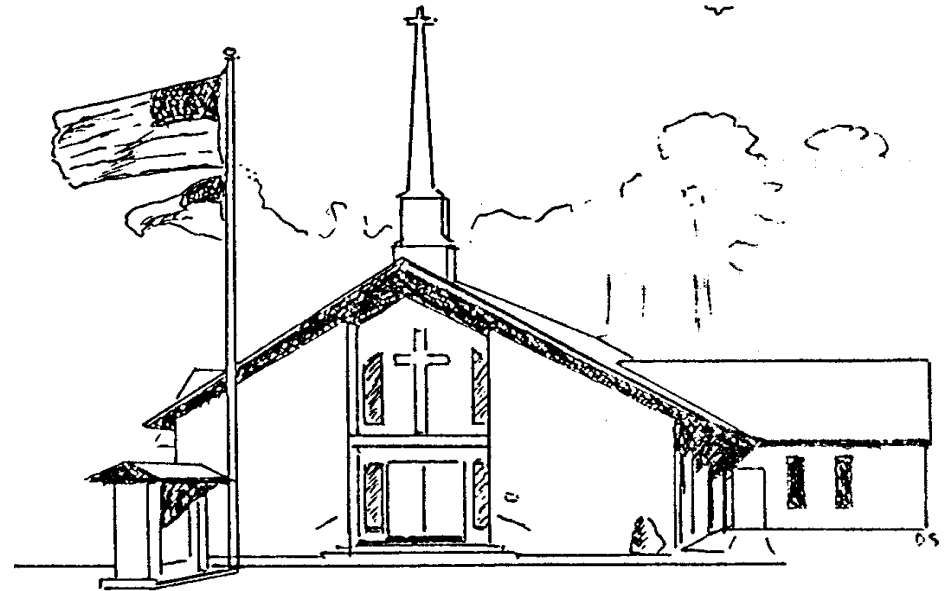
